

Try these groups for **SPEAKERS** on ALL SIDES in your classroom (this list is slightly oriented towards western Washington state; however, some of these groups are national, so wherever you are in the country, try contacting them to arrange for a speaker):

The [American Israel Public Affairs Committee](#) (AIPAC) is “America’s Pro-Israel Lobby” and supports the Israeli government position. It has offices in Seattle and San Francisco, as well as around the country, and is a very powerful lobby in Washington, DC.

[J Street](#) is a national group with a Seattle branch which identifies with a liberal “pro-Israel, pro-Peace” position.

[Jewish Voice for Peace](#) is a national organization. Its Seattle chapter describes itself as supporting “the aspirations of Israelis and Palestinians for security and self-determination, as well as equal rights for all Israeli citizens.”

[Stand With Us](#) is an American group with a [branch](#) in Seattle. SWU usually supports the Israeli government position.

[Students for Justice in Palestine](#) has a presence on many American campuses and focuses on equal rights for Palestinians and Israelis.

[SUPER UW](#) (Students United for Palestinian Equal Rights --University of Washington) “is a diverse student-led group made up of students, faculty, and community members around the University of Washington in Seattle, working to educate students and the broader community about the struggle for Palestinian equal rights.”

[The Palestine Solidarity Committee](#) is a group based in Seattle that focuses on equal rights for Palestinians and Israelis and an end to occupation and apartheid.

[The Rachel Corrie Foundation](#) is based in Olympia and focuses on equal rights for Palestinians and Israelis and an end to occupation and apartheid.

[Voices for Palestine](#) is a group based in Seattle that focuses on equal rights for Palestinians and Israelis and an end to occupation and apartheid.
